Reading Your Bible to Experience God's Glory

SERVICE This is the last Sunday before Ash Wednesday (March 2) and the Lenten Season. This Sunday is traditionally Transfiguration Sunday. On the Mount of Transfiguration, Jesus' reveals God's glory in His person. If we are to experience God's glory, we must know how to read our Bibles. Jesus, in our Gospel Reading, teaches us how to read the Bible, giving us three very practical directions. If we follow these directions, we will experience the amazingly powerful and weighty glory of God in our lives.

RESPONSIVE PSALM READING Psalm 119, selected verses

Pastor: I am laid low in the dust:

People: preserve my life according to Your word.

Pastor: My soul is weary with sorrow;

People: strengthen me according to Your word.

Pastor: Turn my eyes away from worthless things;

People: preserve my life according to Your word.

Pastor: May your unfailing love come to me, LORD,

People: Your salvation, according to Your promise;

Pastor: Remember Your word to Your servant,

People: for You have given me hope.
Pastor: My comfort in my suffering is this:
People: Your promise preserves my life.

Pastor: I have sought Your face with all my heart;

CONFESSION LSB 204 "Lord Have Mercy"

ABSOLUTION LSB 204 "Glory to God in the Highest"

Pastor: The Scriptures are written that we might have real and eternal Life – today and forever. The basic message of the Bible is that Jesus is Son of God who goes to the cross, receiving the just judgment for our self-focused and self-absorbed lives and giving us His undeserved righteousness, that is, His undiluted love, unlimited acceptance, and undeserved forgiveness.

FIRST READING Deuteronomy 30:11-20

¹¹ Now what I am commanding you today is not too difficult for you or beyond your reach. ¹² It is not up in heaven, so that you have to ask, "Who will ascend into heaven to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?"¹³ Nor is it beyond the sea, so that you have to ask, "Who will cross the sea to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?" ¹⁴ No, the word is very near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart so you may obey it.

¹⁵ See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. ¹⁶ For I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in obedience to Him, and to keep His commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase. . .

¹⁷ But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, ¹⁸ I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed. . .

¹⁹ This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live ²⁰ and that you may love the LORD your God, listen to His voice, and hold fast to Him. For the LORD is your life.

EPISTLE READING Romans 10:5-9

⁵ Moses writes this about the righteousness that is by the law: "The person who does these things will live by them." ⁶ But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down) ⁷ "or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). ⁸ But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim: ⁹ If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Reader: These Readings are the Word of the Lord.

People: Thanks be to God.
